

# Poker Tournament Strategy-Fusion of Poker Variants

Poker tournament strategy should be devised with a lot of thoughtfulness. Since the poker tournament is going to be a mix of poker variants there are ample possibility for a player to use the poker tournament strategy devised for holdem to be practiced in an Omaha game. Similarly they might use the no limit poker tournament strategy in a pot limit game. All such wrong application of poker tournament strategy can mean a lot of money loss and a bit of extra price most of the time. To avoid such confusions, thoughtfulness is a must in poker games.

There is going to be a difference in enthusiasm to play guaranteed poker tournaments from playing poker tournaments without any kind of guarantee. If a player has a mind block to play exclusively in guaranteed prize pool poker games, then they might feel lazy to device poker tournament strategy for no guarantee tournaments. An efficient player should place skill first and money next. Regardless of whether the prize money is big or small they will have to play smart with all their skills each and every time. Those players that are controlled by their emotions to play less smart in a no guarantee tournament are essentially weak. Courage and determination should be packed as a skin to all the poker tournament strategy that a player follows. However good one plays, courage has its own charisma in making someone win. There are many moments in poker tourneys where players have made a contributory winning with medium hands with a lot of courage combined in right proportion with skill against players with a comparatively better hand than they. Courage puts in an optimistic charge in the face of the player which has some magnetic energy that provides one to apply poker math skillfully. When closely examined one might be able to understand that most of the reputed players are those that have learnt to remain unpredictable. It is quite possible to calculate and crack through the unpredictable nature of a player. Several hand histories can reveal an outline of the frequency of tight, passive or aggressive playing style. This percentage calculation of the unpredictability of the player can be successfully used to break through the style of the player to make the winning; however, the task is not as simple as it sounds. But when the home work is done the player that succeeds is going to simply get rocking.
